

Instructions for Public Notice after Monitoring Violations for Community PWS

STEP 1: CREATE A PUBLIC NOTICE- The following page titled 'IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER' is a template for your public notice. This template includes the mandatory Public Notice language, which cannot be changed. Fill out the blank lines in the template with following:

- Corrective Actions tell your customers how the violation was corrected.
- Contact Information for the water system including a name or title for a water system official, the address, and a good phone number.

STEP 2: DISTRIBUTE THE PUBLIC NOTICE- The Public Notice must be delivered to your customers as indicated. The Public Notice must be distributed using at least one primary delivery method. If a primary delivery method is not used, then the Public Notice will be rejected.

- The primary delivery method must be mail, hand delivery, or direct delivery to each customer. The Public Notice may be included in the annual CCR.
- The secondary delivery methods should be used if the primary method of delivering the Public Notice will not reach all customers. Secondary delivery methods may include posting in public locations, newspaper, radio, and television.

STEP 3: SEND DEQ THE PUBLIC NOTICE PAPERWORK

The following two documents must be submitted to DEQ within 10 days of delivering the Public Notice to your customers.

- A copy of the Public Notice that was delivered to your customers
- The completed Public Notice Certification (below) showing how and when the Public Notice was delivered to your customers

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Falls Creek Baptist Conference Center

Our water system violated drinking water requirements. Even though this was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct the situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During the following monitoring periods, we did not complete all monitoring or testing for the following contaminants, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.
